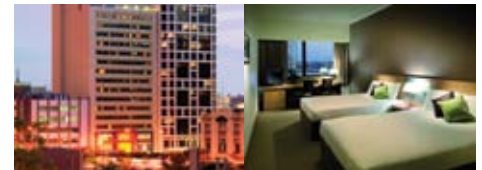

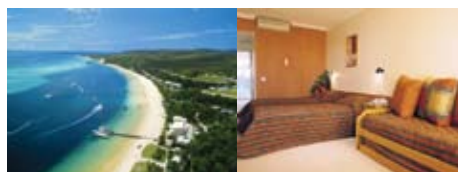

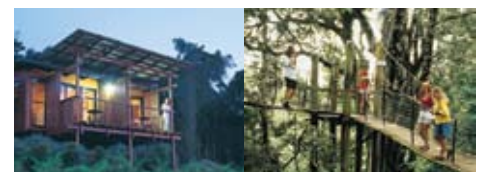
Kingfisher Bay Resort ★★★★★ Fraser Island
