DAY 1 CANADA · GERMANY

Departure on a Lufthansa flight to Germany.

DAY 2 GERMANY · VILNIUS (LITHUANIA)

Arrival in Germany and connection to Vilnius. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. Dinner at your hotel. (D)

► **Accommodation** Best Western Vilnius for 2 nights.

DAY 3 VILNIUS

Breakfast at the hotel. Sightseeing in Vilnius: walking in the narrow medieval streets of the Old Town, you can see much of the architecture which gave Vilnius its name as a Baroque City. Visit of Vilnius Cathedral and churches of St. Peter and Paul, St. Anne and the beautiful Baroque St. Teresa. Lunch. In the afternoon, drive to Trakai and visit Gediminas Castle, a well preserved medieval castle on a picturesque island in the middle of the lake. Dinner at your hotel. (B/L/D)

DAY 4 VILNIUS · NIDA

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Kaunas, second largest city of the country and former capital. City tour and lunch. Transfer to the unique Curonian Spit. (B/L/D)

► **Accommodation** Jurate Hotel for 2 nights.

DAY 5 CURONIAN SPIT (NIDA)

Day at leisure to enjoy this amazing place of dunes and birds between the Baltic Sea and the Curonian Lagoon. (B/L/D)

DAY 6 NIDA · RIGA (LATVIA)

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Latvia with stopover at the Hill of Crosses near Siauliai, the place of expressing gratitude to God for divine favors. Lunch and visit of the Rundale Palace - Latvia's version of Versailles and Sans Soucis, the most significant masterpiece of Baroque architecture in the Baltic States. Arrival in Riga. Dinner at your hotel. (B/L/D)

► **Accommodation** Hanza Hotel for 3 nights.

DAY 7 RIGA

Breakfast at the hotel. Riga city sightseeing tour, highlighting the most significant sites in the medieval Old Town (Dome Cathedral, St. Peter's Church, National Opera House, etc.) and the charming district of Art Nouveau (Jugendstil) buildings. Lunch in the Old Town. In the afternoon, transfer to Jurmala, a seaside resort where you will enjoy the beach. Dinner at a local restaurant in Riga. (B/L/D)

DAY 8 RIGA · SIGULDA · RIGA

Breakfast at the hotel. Full day tour to Sigulda located within the Gauja National Park, 50 km from Riga. You will enjoy the beautiful landscapes, forests and hills. Lunch in Sigulda and then back to Riga where you will have some free time before dinner. (B/L/D)

DAY 9 RIGA · TALLINN (ESTONIA)

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Tallinn via Estonian seaside resort of Parnu. Lunch in Parnu. Dinner at your hotel in Tallinn. (B/L/D)

► **Accommodation** Park Inn Central for 2 nights.

DAY 10 TALLINN

Breakfast at the hotel. City tour of Tallinn in the morning. Visit to the Rocca-al-Mare, the Estonian Ethnography Museum to appreciate the great culture of this small country. After lunch, walking city tour to discover the beautiful medieval Old Town: Tallinn Town Hall, The City Fortification Wall with defense towers, Toompea Castle, Alexander Nevski Cathedral, and others. Feel the charm and mystery of the narrow medieval cobbled streets, fortification walls and towers. In the afternoon, free time in Old Town. Dinner at your hotel in Tallinn. (B/L/D)

DAY 11 TALLINN · GERMANY · CANADA

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for your flights back to Canada. (B)
