### DAY 1 MOSCOW

Arrival in Moscow and private transfer to hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. Dinner at your hotel. (D)

▶ **Accommodation** Renaissance Monarch for 4 nights.

### DAY 2 MOSCOW

Breakfast. Morning guided city tour including the Red Square with St. Basil's Cathedral, recognizable with its 10 colorful onion-shaped domes (outside view). Drive to Sparrow Hills to see the Olympic stadium and the building of the Moscow State University. Afternoon, guided visit of Tretyakov Art Gallery and Russian bath experience at Sanduny's. Dinner at your hotel. (B/D)

### DAY 3 MOSCOW

Breakfast. Morning guided visit of the Kremlin, the oldest part of the city. You will enter one of the cathedrals, visit the Armoury Museum and the Grand Kremlin Palace, an imperial residence. Dinner at your hotel. (B/D)

### DAY 4 MOSCOW

Breakfast. Excursion to Kolomenskoye, imperial residence located a few kilometers out of town where Peter the Great spent his childhood. Back to Moscow for a cruise on the Moskova River. Dinner at your hotel. (B/D)

### DAY 5 MOSCOW · ST. PETERSBURG

Breakfast. Morning guided walking tour along the old Arbat street. Guided visit of Moscow's metro. Transfer to the railway station to take the train to St. Petersburg. Arrival in late afternoon and transfer to your hotel. Dinner at your hotel. (B/D)

▶ **Accommodation** Corinthia Hotel for 4 nights.

### DAY 6 ST. PETERSBURG

Breakfast. Departure for a guided sightseeing tour of St. Petersburg, a city of beautiful baroque palaces, picturesque canals, splendid avenues and elaborate cathedrals. Guided visit of Peter and Paul Fortress. In the afternoon, visit of the Spilled Blood Church. Dinner at your hotel. (B/D)

### DAY 7 ST. PETERSBURG

Breakfast. Morning guided visit of the Hermitage Museum including the two Golden Rooms, one of the largest museums in the world. Visit of St. Isaac Cathedral and Yusupov Palace. Dinner at your hotel. (B/D)

Breakfast. Morning guided excursion to Tsarskoye Selo to visit Catherine's Palace. Farewell dinner at a local restaurant. (B/D)
