Morning guided city tour where you will see Red Square with St. Basil's Cathedral, recognizable with its 10 colorful onion-shaped domes (outside view). Drive to Sparrow Hills to see the Olympic stadium and the building of the Moscow State University. Afternoon, guided visit of Tretyakov Art Gallery. In the evening, you will attend a circus performance. Dinner at your hotel. (B/D)

**DAY 4 MOSCOW**

Morning guided visit of the Kremlin, the oldest part of the city. You will enter one of the cathedrals and visit the Armoury Museum. Dinner at your hotel. (B/D)

**DAY 5 MOSCOW · ST. PETERSBURG**

Morning guided walking tour along the old Arbat street. Guided visit of Moscow's metro. Transfer to the railway station to take the train to St. Petersburg. Arrival late afternoon and transfer to your hotel. Dinner at your hotel. (B/D)

▶ **Accommodation** Dostoevsky Hotel for 4 nights.**DAY 6 ST. PETERSBURG**

Departure for a guided sightseeing tour of St. Petersburg, a city of beautiful baroque palaces, picturesque canals, splendid avenues and elaborate cathedrals. Guided visit of Peter and Paul Fortress. Afternoon is at leisure. Dinner at your hotel. (B/D)
